



Tips for family and/or kids sessions

Schedule

Schedule your session during your child's upbeat time of the day. Make sure they are well rested.

Bring necessary items to help keep your child happy and clean, diapers, wipes, snacks, favorite toys, blankets.

Bring along some personal props - costumes, hats, or toys that showcase your child's personality.

Bring the **family dog** along if you like

Mix up the wardrobe

When picking a wardrobe, think bold and bright. Maybe even stripes or patterns. For families, it is best to dress everyone in the same style, color or choose a pattern for one person and

have the others play off the colors in that pattern.

Long sleeves, or short sleeves look better on adults than sleeveless tops.

Bring a variety.

Casual, formal or something that is "so your child." It will help us capture your child's true self.

Include other people in the portrait of a baby or child. Holding hands with mom and dad, or grandparents. Siblings kissing or holding a new addition to the family.

Remember to think about socks and shoes, or maybe just barefoot.

We like to try to get a variety of expressions - to capture a personality.

About 20-25 minutes will be for the session, (longer if necessary) and another 30 minutes to review and make selections. Or you can schedule a later time to come in and review the images.



Be positive, and upbeat.

Kids can feel your moods.

What makes you look slimmer?

Dark clothing, especially pants. Clothes that fit properly, shoes with heels, long sleeve clothing.

What adds weight?

Sleeveless clothing, white or light garments, horizontal stripes.

What makes you look taller?

Similar tones top and bottom lengthen your appearance, shoes with heels.

What makes you look shorter?

Outfits with a lot of contrast, flat shoes.
